## Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Amendment Application for Air New Source Review Permit Numbers 95754 and N320

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Intercontinental Terminals Company, LLC., (CN 601470222) has submitted an application for an amendment to permit numbers 95754 and N320. The ITC Pasadena Terminal (RN 106119175) is a bulk liquid storage terminal at 1030 Ethyl Road, Pasadena, Harris County.

This amendment will authorize the construction of thirty-seven storage tanks, marine loading docks, a truck rack, three emergency generators, five vapor combustion units, and associated piping components. Intercontinental Terminals Company, LLC., has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

The facilities included in this amendment are controlled by tank seals, vapor combustion devices, leak detection programs, and limited duration of operation.
