

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal  
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 9730**

*The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.*

Evonik Oil Additives USA, Inc. (CN604169367) has submitted an application for renewal of permit number 9730. The Evonik Oil Additives USA (RN101383859) produces/manufactures chemical oil additives at 1700 Tidal Road, Deer Park, Harris County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of the Methacrylate Separation Unit. Evonik Oil Additives USA, Inc. has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.

Organic Compounds	3.61

The facilities being renewed continue to be controlled by the use of fixed-roof organic liquid storage tanks, leak detection and repair program to minimize piping leaks, and condensers capable of achieving 97% recovery.
