

**Plain Language Summary for New Source Review (NSR) Renewal Amendment
Application for Air New Source Review Permit Number 9981**

The following summary is provided for this pending air permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Printpack, Inc. (CN600329916) has submitted an application for renewal of and amendment to permit number 9981. The Grand Prairie Converting Plant (RN100211291) produces/manufactures printed or laminated flexible packaging at 2005 South Great Southwest Parkway, Grand Prairie, Tarrant County.

This renewal will authorize the continued operation of Printpack’s Converting plant that includes flexographic printing, lamination, and slitting operations. The amendment will authorize extrusion lamination 35 throughput changes, change in materials stored, maximum hourly throughputs, and emission routing. Printpack has listed in the application the pollutants and amounts that will be emitted for each facility. Below is the current amount allowed, the amount to be added or removed, and the total amount for each pollutant that is proposed to be emitted each year for all the facilities.
