

APD NSR PERMIT PROCESSING UPDATE

- As of June 1, 2019, the use of the NSR Application workbook is required for NSR case-by-case initial, amendment, alteration, and renewal permits.
- The NSR Application workbook has been re-named the Form PI-1 General Application and replaces the previous PDF and word versions of the PI-1, PI-1R, PI-1D, Table 30, Table 30R, and Table 1(a) which are no longer available.
- The NSR workbook has been updated to address the requirements of 30 TAC Chapter 116.
- If applicable, applicants will also submit an Electronic Modeling Evaluation Workbook (EMEW) or attach Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) protocols.
- TCEQ may not accept incomplete applications. Please ensure that the application is submitted using the applicable workbook and includes completed information, attachments, and information required for public notice.
- Applications will be assigned immediately to permit reviewers and modeling staff and reviewed concurrently.
- APD will continue to determine administrative completeness at the beginning of the process, usually within ten days.
- Deficiencies will be identified earlier in the process and follow the procedure in 30 TAC § 116.114.
- Response times to any Notice of Deficiency (NOD) will be based upon the complexity of the application and the level of deficiency.
- Applications that are deficient may be voided.
- If an applicant fails to submit comments concerning a draft permit for which notice is not required, the TCEQ may issue the final permit consistent with the draft permit.
