Current Position

Hannah Cobos began her employment with the TCEQ in February 2023 as an Environmental Permit Specialist on the Stormwater Team within the Wastewater Permitting Section of the Water Quality Division. Her work includes writing individual stormwater discharge permits and conducting technical reviews of Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Stormwater Management Programs. In addition, Hannah provides technical assistance to regulated entities and the public concerning the Construction General Permit (TXR150000), Multi-Sector General Permit (TXR050000), and the Phase II Small MS4 General Permit (TXR040000) under the TPDES program.

Prior Experience and Education

Hannah graduated *Magna Cum Laude* with a Bachelor of Science in Environmental Science from the University of Texas at San Antonio in December 2021. During her educational career, she participated in a university coordinated program with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency as a student intern, further developing her working knowledge of the regulatory framework guiding the TPDES program under the Clean Water Act. Her coursework including environmental law, watershed health, and the source, fate, and transport of point source discharges serves as a basis for her work today in environmental permitting.
