# **B.** Alternative Language Determination

The purpose of this section is to record the steps you took to determine whether a Bilingual Education Program is required by Title 19 Texas Education Code (19 TEC), Section 89.1205, in the school district where the facility is located and, if so, whether you are required to publish your public notice in an alternative language.
