Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision for Hazardous Industrial Waste Post-Closure Order

Proposed Post-Closure Order No. PCO33095

APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION. Nucor Corporation, 8812 Highway 79 West, Jewett, Leon County, Texas 75846, a steel mill, has applied to Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a post-closure order to authorize a compliance plan and post-closure care for a Corrective Action Management Unit. The facility is located at the address stated above. This application was received by the TCEQ on April 1, 2022. The TCEQ executive director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft post-closure order. The draft post-closure order, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must conduct post-closure and groundwater corrective action/remediation, based on commercial/industrial land use. The executive director has made a preliminary decision that this post-closure order, if issued, would meet all statutory and regulatory requirements. The post-closure order application, executive director's preliminary decision, and draft post-closure order are available for viewing and copying at the Jewett Library, 103 Robinson Avenue, Jewett, Leon County, Texas 75846.

PUBLIC COMMENT. You may submit public comments on this application. The executive director will respond to timely comments raising issues that are relevant and material or otherwise significant to the Commission's decision on the application. If the executive director files a response to public comment, the chief clerk will transmit the response to public comment to persons who submitted comments during the comment period and persons who requested to be added to the mailing list for this action.

COMMISSION ACTION. The Commission must take final action on the post-closure order application at a scheduled Commission meeting.

MAILING LIST. If you submit public comments, you will be added to the mailing list for this application to receive future public notices mailed by the Office of the Chief Clerk. In addition, you may request to be placed on: (1) the permanent mailing list for a specific applicant name and permit number; and/or (2) the mailing list for a specific county.
