The purpose of this permit modification, submitted on behalf of Abilene Landfill TX, LP, is to relocate the permanent leachate evaporation pond and to request to allow additional temporary leachate evaporation ponds, consistent with the design and specifications included in Attachment 10E – Leachate Storage Pond Liner Quality Control Plan and Attachment 15 – Leachate and Contaminated Water Plan of the permit, at the Abilene Landfill.

To facilitate TCEQ’s review, a redline/strikeout format (Appendix A) version has been developed for the attached permit modification and Appendix B includes an unmarked (i.e., clean) version of the attached permit modification. In addition, the following table has been developed to summarize the attached replacement pages for this permit modification.



4.4 Onsite Leachate Storage Pond

The proposed leachate storage pond will consist of a two-foot-thick compacted clay liner overlain by a 60-mil geomembrane. The storage pond liner components will be constructed in accordance with Appendix 10E of Attachment 10 – Soils and Liner Quality Control Plan. The leachate storage pond will be maintained to store a maximum amount of leachate to provide one foot of freeboard for the maximum leachate capacity and a 25-year, 24-hour storm event. Leachate storage capacity calculations and sequencing are provided in Appendix 15D.

The location of the proposed permanent leachate storage pond is shown on Figure 15D-4. The site has the option to construct the permanent pond outside the permitted footprint, as shown on Figure 15D-4, or temporary ponds within the permitted footprint (outside constructed areas), to facilitate site operations. Please note, only ~~two~~one leachate storage ponds will be in operation at any given time. The leachate storage ponds, regardless of location, will be constructed in accordance with Appendix 10E – Leachate Storage Pond Liner Quality Control Plan of Attachment 10 and Appendix 15D – Storage Pond and Storage Tank Calculations, operated in accordance with the approved Site Operating Plan, and closed in accordance with the procedure listed in Section 2.1 of Attachment 13 – Postclosure Care Plan.
