## Notice of Application and Preliminary Decision for Municipal Solid Waste Permit Modification

Permit No. 1590B

**Application and Preliminary Decision.** City of Denton has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a permit modification to authorize an increase of the estimated maximum waste acceptance rate from 328,500 tons per year (900 tons per day) to 912,500 tons per year (2,500 tons per day). The facility is located at 1527 S. Mayhill Road, Denton, 76208, in Denton County, Texas. TCEQ received this application on March 24, 2026. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit modification. The draft modification, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit modification, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements.
