On behalf of Waste Management of Texas, Inc., the enclosed is a permit modification for the Skyline Landfill, TCEQ Permit No. MSW 42D. This permit modification has been prepared to be consistent with Title 30 of the Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §305.70(k). This permit modification includes revisions to Part III, Attachment F - Groundwater Monitoring Plan, that proposes the replacement/relocation of MW-10 and MW-23 due to damage. A permit modification narrative is included in this submittal.

Please process this permit modification request per §305.70(k)(4), which allows for changes to groundwater monitor well depth or design that are consistent with the groundwater characterization and approved monitoring system design, and that improve the effectiveness of the system in detecting contamination. PERMIT MODIFICATION NARRATIVE

Background

A certified and TCEQ approved Subtitle D groundwater monitoring system is in place at the Skyline Landfill. The existing groundwater monitoring system consists of a total of 34 monitoring wells, of which 4 wells are upgradient and 29 wells are downgradient.

Proposed Permit Modification

Due to intermittent high turbidity readings at both MW-10 and MW-23 during recent groundwater monitoring events, a site inspection was conducted by Biggs & Mathew's Environmental (BME) and Waste Management of Texas, Inc. (WMTX) personnel to investigate possible sources. Upon visual inspection of MW-10 it was observed that the well had a substantial lean to one side. In addition, a significant amount of soil had accumulated on and around the well pad as a result of site operations in the vicinity of the well. A downhole camera was placed in MW-10 to provide an internal video inspection. During the review of the video footage, it appeared that the joint seal at approximately 2 feet from the top of casing may have been compromised, as evidenced by the presence of a discolored dried residue at the joint seal, that may have allowed surface infiltration to the wellbore. Upon further internal inspection of the well, an obstruction was viewed near the bottom of the well that stretched horizontally across the well. Video inspection was then conducted for MW-23. At approximately 7 feet from top of casing, significant damage to the PVC material was observed. The camera was unable to advance past the damage and the dedicated pump was unable to be released from the well for further evaluation. Upon completion of the investigation, it was determined that the integrity of MW-10 and MW-23 were both compromised and that each well would need to be replaced in order to collect representative groundwater samples from these locations.

Rather than replacing the wells in the general vicinity of their current locations, it was determined that relocating these two wells to the north, away from current site operations would alleviate future issues with the accumulation of soil in and around the monitor well pads. As such, monitoring well MW-10 is proposed to be relocated approximately 160 feet northwest of the current location and will be identified as MW-10R. Monitoring well MW-23 is proposed to be relocated approximately 76 feet north of the current location and will be identified as MW-23R. Each of the relocated wells will be within 500-feet of the original waste footprint, as defined by 30 TAC §330.3. Each of these replacement wells will be monitored on a quarterly basis for two years, in accordance with §330.407(a). The approved background limits for the wells being replaced with be used until new background limits can be established.

Replacement monitoring wells MW-10R and MW-23R will have similar design details as MW-10 and MW-23 (4" in diameter and screened across the interface of the weathered/unweathered Taylor Marl contact). Monitoring well MW-10R and MW-23R will be screened at the appropriate interval that will monitor the full saturated thickness of the

uppermost aquifer, consistent with the monitoring well system design approved in the Subchapter J permit modification and 2015 permit amendment.

This modification has been prepared in accordance with §305.70(k) - for those modifications requiring notice, the permittee or registrant must send notice of the modification application by first-class mail in accordance with §39.106 of this title and to all persons listed in §39.413 of this title. The required Adjacent Property Owners List is provided in Attachment 1 to this permit modification. The Adjacent Property Owners List identifies those property owners that are adjacent to or within ¼ mile of the permit boundary, mineral interest ownership under the facility, and the facility easement holders. The adjacent property owners identified were from Dallas and Ellis Counties Tax Appraisal District records.

The replacement of MW-10 and MW-23 is proposed under $\S305.70(k)(4)$ – for changes to groundwater monitor well depth or design that are consistent with the groundwater characterization and approved monitoring system design, and that improve the effectiveness of the system in detecting contamination.

The plugging of MW-10 and MW-23 will be under 305.70(j)(27) – the plugging of groundwater monitoring wells when the executive director has determined that the plugging of monitoring wells is appropriate in various situations, including when a monitoring well is being replaced. °




