<p>c. The owner/operator will apply for a Scrap Tire Facility registration if the owner/operator cuts, bails, shreds or processes tires on-site for volume reduction.</p>	Yes
<p>d. The owner/operator will monitor tires stored outside for vectors; utilize vector control measures at least once every two weeks.</p>	Yes
<p>e. The owner/operator will document the removal and management of all scrap tires and tire pieces using manifests and retain related records for a period of three years.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A manifest form template (TCEQ-10304) is included as Appendix B. <p>f. If the owner/operator is not self-transporting the tires to an authorized scrap tire facility for end-use, recycling, or disposal, the owner/operator will use a registered transporter to remove the used or scrap tires generated on-site.</p>	Yes
<p>g. The owner/operator will ensure that the transporter who collects the tires or tire pieces on-site will deliver them to an authorized facility.</p>	Yes
<p>h. The owner/operator will obtain the completed manifest within 60 days after the scrap tires or tire pieces were transported off-site by the authorized transporter.</p>	Yes

Appendix B - Checklist for Scrap Tire Generator Registration Application

Review the checklist below to ensure your application is complete before submitting.

The generator business will store more than 500 used or scrap tires and will obtain a registration.

Completed Generator Application - Form TCEQ-10297g (Reference: 30 TAC §328.55 - General Requirements and 30 TAC § 328.56 – Generator Requirements).

- a. Include: Name of business entity as per tax records, address, city and county, telephone number, fax number, active tax ID number (*as provided by the Office of the Texas State Comptroller; Telephone No: 1-800-252-1386; <https://comptroller.texas.gov/>).
- b. Sign and date application.

Completed TCEQ Core Data Form (TCEQ-10400).

Determine if a Storage Site Registration is required – A storage facility registration application is required if a generator stores more than 500 scrap tires (or the equivalent in tire pieces) on the ground or more than 2,000 scrap tires (or the equivalent in tire pieces) in an enclosed lockable container.
