Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG920750

Application. Mahard Egg Farm, Inc., P.O. Box 248, Prosper, Texas 75078 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The notice of change is to correct the mistake that was made in the 2014 renewal application. The Applicant selected chickens/broilers (SIC Code 0251) instead of laying hens (SIC Code 0252). The currently authorized headcount of 3,480,000 laying hens remains unchanged. The notice of change application was received by TCEQ on September 10, 2015. No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at 21080 County Road 87 N, Chillicothe, Wilbarger County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Upper Pease/North Fork Pease River in Segment No. 0220 of the Red River River Basin.

The Executive Director of the TCEQ has approved the proposed non-substantial change to the terms of the NMP. The revised terms of the NMP have been included in the permit record and it is available at the TCEQ's Central Records, 12100 Park 35 Circle Austin, Texas 78753.
