Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG920759

Application. Skyward Dairy, 1900 Navajo Trail, Dalhart, Texas 79022 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is updating the land management unit (LMU) map to show each LMU acreage as a whole, not based on field splits consistent with cropping plans as previously represented. The currently authorized total land application area of 2,883 acres remains unchanged. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on October 12, 2015. No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located 3850 County Road G, Dalhart, Hartley County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Canadian River Above Lake Meredith in Segment No. 0103 of the Canadian River Basin.

The Executive Director of the TCEQ has approved the proposed non-substantial change to the terms of the NMP. The revised terms of the NMP have been included in the permit record and it is available at the TCEQ's Central Records, 12100 Park 35 Circle Austin, Texas 78753.
