Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921095

Application. D & J Dairy, P.O Box 2050, Amarillo, Texas 79105 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The CAFO is updating the land management unit (LMU) map to show each LMU acreage, not based on field splits consistent with cropping plans as previously represented. In addition, the CAFO is decreasing the acreage of LMU 13 – from 120 acres to 93 acres. The total LMU acreage has decreased from 3,414 acres to 3,371 acres. Other proposed changes include addition of RCS #3 and confinement pens. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on May 20, 2015. No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located 9 Miles north of the intersection of Farm-to-Market Road 1057 and Farm-to-Market Road 1058 on Farm-to-Market Road 1057, Hereford, Deaf Smith County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Upper Prairie Dog in Segment No. 0229 of the Red River River Basin.

The Executive Director of the TCEQ has approved the proposed non-substantial change to the terms of the NMP. The revised terms of the NMP have been included in the permit record and it is available at the TCEQ's Central Records, 12100 Park 35 Circle Austin, TX 78753.
