Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921325

Application. North Star Dairy, LLC, 295 U.S. Highway 385, Hereford, Texas 79045 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The CAFO is decreasing the acreage of LMU 1 – from 42 acres to 12 acres. The total land application acreage has decreased from 42 acres to 12 acres. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on July 14, 2015. No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located on the west side of Farm-to-Market Road 1057, 6 miles west of Hereford, 1.5 miles south of the intersection of Farm-to-Market Road 1057 and Farm-to-Market Road 1058, Hereford, Deaf Smith County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Upper Prairie Dog in Segment No. 0229 of the Red River River Basin.

The Executive Director of the TCEQ has approved the proposed non-substantial change to the terms of the NMP. The revised terms of the NMP have been included in the permit record and it is available at the TCEQ's Central Records, 12100 Park 35 Circle Austin, Texas 78753.
