Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921432

Application. Richard Heida, 12701 Sierra View Drive, Oakdale, California 95361 and High Noon Dairy, LLC, 8919 Merrill Avenue, Chino, California 91710 have applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicants are renaming the land management units (LMUs) but the acreage remains the same. LMU #4 - 120 acres is now LMU #6, LMU #5 - 120 acres is now LMU #7, LMU #6 - 120 acres is now LMU #5 and LMU #7 - 120 acres is now LMU #4. The currently authorized total land application area of 880 acres remains unchanged. Other changes to the facility include a revision to the calculations for retention control structure (RCS) #1, the addition of two dry cow pens southeast of the facility and the removal of proposed pens and RCS #5 west of the facility. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on February 1, 2016.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at 5155 Farm-to-Market Road 1057, Hereford in Deaf Smith County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Upper Prairie Dog Town Fork Red River in Segment No. 0229 of the Red River River Basin.

The Executive Director of the TCEQ has approved the proposed non-substantial change to the terms of the NMP. The revised terms of the NMP have been included in the permit record and it is available at the TCEQ's Central Records, 12100 Park 35 Circle Austin, Texas 78753.
