Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921439

Application. Red River Valley Egg Farm, LLC., 3320 W Woodrow Wilson Avenue, Jackson, Mississippi 39209 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is removing Land Management Unit (LMU) #2 – 10 acres and decreasing the acreage of LMU #1 from 48 to 15 acres. The total land application area has decreased from 58 to 15 acres. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on November 9, 2016.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at south side of County Road 1200, approximately 1 mile west of the intersection of County Road 1200 and Highway 37, Bogata, Red River County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Sulphur/South Sulphur in Segment No. 0303 of the Red River River Basin.

The Executive Director of the TCEQ has approved the proposed non-substantial change to the terms of the NMP. The revised terms of the NMP have been included in the permit record and it is available at the TCEQ's Central Records, 12100 Park 35 Circle Austin, Texas 78753.
