

Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG920440

Application. Hansford County Feeders LP, 13800 County Road 19, Spearman, Texas 79081 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is proposing to reconfigure the land management units (LMUs) to decrease the acreage of LMU 1A (formerly LMU 1A -north half circle) from 108 to 86.5 acres and LMU 1B (formerly LMU 1B -south half circle) from 108 to 104 acres; and remove LMU 3 east field by feedmill -94 acres to incorporate a pen area. LMU 2 –west field and corners – 251 acres has been renamed LMU 2 with no change to the acreage. The total LMU acreage has decreased from 561.01 to 441.5 acres. Other changes include updating the facility maps to reflect constructed and proposed pen areas and boundaries of reconfigured LMUs; revising the design calculations for retention control structures (RCSs) to combine and rename the RCSs; and removing RCS #9. The names and RCSs total required capacities without freeboard are: RCSs 1-3 (System 1) - 50.27 ac-ft, RCSs 4 - 6 (System 2) - 135.51 ac-ft, RCS 7 (System 3) - 18.59 ac-ft and RCS 8 (System 4) - 28.14 ac-ft. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on August 4, 2017.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at 13800 County Road 19, Spearman, Hansford County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of Palo Duro Reservoir in Segment No. 0199A of the Canadian River Basin.
