Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG920715

Application. Dalhart Jersey Ranch Inc., 1550 Farm-to-Market Road 1727, Dalhart, Texas 79022 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is removing land management unit (LMU) #35 – 68 acres, and changing the configuration of LMU #37 – 68 acres and removing the pivot. The total LMU acreage that is available for land application has decreased from 2,223 to 2,155 acres. The facility maps have been updated to reflect the current layout of the site. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on October 2, 2017.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at 1550 Farm-to-Market Road 1727, Dalhart, Dallam County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Rita Blanca Lake in Segment No. 0105 of the Canadian River Basin.
