Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921410

Application. Prestage Farms of Oklahoma LLC, P.O. Box 509, Texhoma, Oklahoma 73949 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is proposing to decrease the number of total swine from 23,600 head to a maximum of 16,700 head, of which 8,800 head will be swine weighing less than 55 Lbs and 7,900 head will be swine weighing 55 Lbs or over. The currently authorized total land application area of 212 acres remains unchanged. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on May 18, 2017.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located approximately 200 feet north and 400 feet west of the intersection of County Road L (Purnell Road) and County Road 3, Sherman County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of an unclassified segment of Segment No. 0100 of the Canadian River Basin.
