Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921445

Application. Jess Visser, Jess and Gail Visser Family Trust, & Gail Visser, 31988 Taylor Avenue, Mc Farland, California 93250 have applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is updating the land management unit (LMU) map to show each LMU acreage as a whole, not based on field splits consistent with cropping plans as previously represented; and decrease the acreage of LMU 13C from 90 to 60 acres. Another proposed change is to correct the acreage of LMU 14 (which includes LMU 14A, 14B & 14C). The total LMU acreage has decreased from 1,056 to 1,044 acres. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on June 2, 2017.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at 2461 Farm-to-Market Road 1842 in Springlake, Lamb County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the White River Lake in Segment No. 1240 of the Brazos River Basin.
