Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG920081

Application. Jake Dennis Myrick, 2278 County Road 528, Hart, Texas 79043 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is proposing to remove field splits that was based on cropping plans from the land management units (LMU) map to show each LMU acreage as a whole; and decrease the acreage of LMU 3 from 100 to 93 acres to incorporate pen areas. The total land application area has decreased from 897 to 890 acres. Another change to the feedyard is the addition of new wells. The facility maps have been updated to reflect the changes. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on May 25, 2018.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located on County Road 528, 2.5 miles east of the intersection of County Road 528 and Farm-to-Market Road 168 in Hart, Castro County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the White River Lake in Segment No. 1240 of the Brazos River Basin. The Executive Director of the TCEQ has approved the proposed non-substantial change to the terms of the NMP. The revised terms of the NMP have been included in the permit record and it is available at the TCEQ's Central Records, 12100 Park 35 Circle Austin, Texas 78753.
