Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921045

Application. Arturo Lomeli Briseno, 2940 County Road 406, Stephenville, Texas 76401 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant has decreased the acreage of two land management units (LMU): LMU 1 from 19 to 17 acres and LMU 2 from 13 to 12 acres. The total land application area has decreased from 128 to 125 acres. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on September 4, 2018.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located approximately 3.7 miles past intersection of Farm-to-Market Road 219 and County Road 403, on east side of County Road 403, Stephenville, Erath County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Leon River Below Leon Reservoir in Segment No. 1223 of the Brazos River Basin.
