Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921414

Application. Cnossen Dairy, LLC, 5155 County Road EE, Hereford, Texas 79045 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is reconfiguring land management unit (LMU) LMU 12 – 250 acres to form LMU 12A – 120 acres and LMU 12B – 120 acres and decreasing the acreage of LMU 13 from 125 to 115 acres to incorporate pen and expansion areas. The total land application area has decreased from 1,264 to 1,244 acres. Other changes include the revision of design calculations for the retention control structure #4 and the addition of wells. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on July 26, 2018.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at 5155 County Road EE, Hereford, Deaf Smith County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Upper Prairie Dog Town Fork Red River in Segment No. 0229 of the Red River Basin.
