Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921430

Application. Pete Vanderham Dairy, Inc., 314 Hickory Street, Hereford, Texas 79045 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant has decreased the acreage of land management unit (LMU) #6 – from 90 to 76 acres based on facility road and decreased the total land application area from 610 to 596 acres. The facility maps have been updated to reflect the change in LMU acreage and the as built construction of the dairy. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on July 25, 2018.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located 4.5 miles north of the intersection of 15th Street and US highway 385. Site is located on the east side of US highway 385 in Hereford, Deaf Smith County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Upper Prairie Dog Town Fork Red River in Segment No. 0229 of the Red River Basin.
