

Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921468

Application. Friona Industries, LP, 600 US Highway 60, Bovina, Texas 79009 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is adding two evaporation cells and updating facility calculations to account for total evaporation, also updating facility maps to reflect recent modifications and change in property boundaries. The Applicant is also removing LMU 1- 33 acres, LMU 1C- 21 acres and LMU 3-159 acres, as well as reducing the acreage of LMU 2 from 67 acres to 32 acres due to property boundary change. The new total LMU acreage has decreased from 280 acres to 32 acres. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on March 9, 2017.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located in Parmer County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the White River Lake in Segment No. 1240 of the Brazos River Basin.
