## Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921491

**Application.** Stanley Ray Jones, 708 East 2nd street, Portales, New Mexico 88130 and Blue Sky Farms, LLC, 2450 Highway 86, Friona, Texas 79035 have applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicants are proposing to decrease the acreage of LMU 2 – from 59 to 54 acres to incorporate commodity area, and decrease the total land application area from 206 to 201 acres. In addition, the facility maps and the design calculations for the retention control structures have been updated to include expanded commodity area and drainage system. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on May 25, 2018.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at 14527 North County Road 3700, Idalou, Lubbock County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Salt Fork Brazos River in Segment No. 1238 of the Brazos River Basin.
