Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921492

Application. Kornelis Wilt Vanderlei and Piertsje DeBoer Vanderlei, 1054 U.S. Highway 84, Amherst, Texas 79312 have applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a nonsubstantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is proposing to decrease the acreage of the land management unit #41 from 120 to 63 acres to incorporate a pen area and retention control structure (RCS) #3. The total land application area has decreased from 769 to 712 acres. The design calculations for the RCSs #1, #2 and #3 have been revised and the facility maps have been updated to reflect the changes. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on April 23, 2019.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at 1220 County Road 182, Amherst, Lamb County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Double Mountain Fork Brazos River in Segment No. 1241 of the Brazos River Basin.
