Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG920223

Application. J & S Dairies, LLC, 1260 County Road 1038, Muleshoe, Texas 79347 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is proposing to remove field split from land management units (LMU): LMU 1A (60 acres) and 1B (60 acres) and LMU 2A (60 acres) and 2B (60 acres) on the LMU map to form a full pivot (120 acres); and decrease the acreage of LMU 4 from 101 to 54 acres. The total land application area has decreased from 555 to 508 acres. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on February 1, 2019.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at 1260 County Road 1038, Muleshoe, Bailey County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Double Mountain Fork of the Brazos River in Segment No. 1241 of the Brazos River Basin.
