Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG920297

Application. Eltje Frans Brand, P.O. Box 11 Energy, Energy, Texas 76452 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant has decreased the acreage of land management unit #1 from 60 to 55 acres to expand Slurry Basins #3 and #4 and add a new Slurry Basin #5. The total land application area has decreased from 463 to 458 acres. Other changes include the addition of a new parlor, and the expansion of the north pen and the existing freestall barn. The facility maps and the retention control structure design calculations have also been updated. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on February 13, 2019.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at 14750 Highway 16, Comanche, Comanche County, Texas 76442. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Leon River Below Proctor Lake in Segment No. 1221 of the Brazos River Basin.
