Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921106

Application. Daisy Farms, LLC, 12750 Merit Drive, Suite 600, Dallas, Texas 75251 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is proposing to reconfigure two land management units (LMUs): LMU #2210 – 66 acres and LMU #2240 - 124 to form three LMUs: LMU 2210 – 20 acres, LMU 2240 - 67 acres and LMU #2245 – 66 acres. The total land application area has decreased from 4,562 to 4,525 acres. The following LMUs have been renamed: LMUs #1130 and #1140 (formerly LMU #1030 and LMU #1040, respectively). The facility maps and the NMP have been updated to reflect these changes. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on February 19, 2019.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located at 4482 Highway 24 Paris, Lamar County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the North Sulphur River in Segment No. 0305 of the Sulphur River Basin.
