Notice of Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation Application General Permit Authorization No. TXG921549

Application. La Perla Land & Livestock, LLC, P.O. Box 2738, Weatherford, Texas 76446 has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) under General Permit No. TXG920000 for a non-substantial change to the terms of the nutrient management plan (NMP) previously submitted to the TCEQ. The Applicant is decreasing the acreage for land management unit #3 from 54 to 34 acres. The total land application area will decrease from 79 to 59 acres. Another proposed change is the increase in the open lots which necessitated the revision to the design calculations for retention control structure (RCS)#1. The authorized maximum capacity of 5,000 head of beef cattle will remain the same. The notice of change application and the updated NMP were received by TCEQ on October 8, 2019.

No discharge of pollutants into the waters in the state is authorized by this general permit except under chronic or catastrophic rainfall conditions or events. All waste and wastewater will be beneficially used on agricultural land.

The facility is located 6264 south Farm-to-Market Road 219, Dublin, Erath County, Texas. The facility is located in the drainage area of the Leon River Below Proctor Lake in Segment No. 1221 of the Brazos River Basin.
