The following summary is provided for this pending water quality permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Dallas Fort Worth International Airport Board, c/o Environmental Affairs Department (CN601700610) operates Dallas Fort Worth International Airport RN100213990, an international airport. The facility is located at 2400 Aviation Drive, in DFW Airport, in Dallas and Tarrant County, Texas 75261. The facility is requesting renewal to discharge first flush stormwater and other stormwater to outfalls 001, 019, 020, 023, and 059.

Discharges from the facility are expected to contain oil and grease, total petroleum hydrocarbon, glycol, aluminum, copper, zinc, and pH. First flush stormwater and other stormwater is treated by gravity separation by fuel separators located throughout industrial ramp areas, and by primary treatment at the Airport's first flush stormwater treatment plant.

PLANTILLA EN ESPAÑOL PARA SOLICITUDES NUEVAS/RENOVACIONES/ENMIENDAS DE TPDES o TLAP

AGUAS RESIDUALES INDUSTRIALES/AGUAS PLUVIALES

La junta directiva del Aeropuerto Internacional de Dallas Fort Worth, junto al Departamento de Asuntos Ambientales (CN601700610), opera el Aeropuerto Internacional de Dallas Fort Worth, RN100213990, un aeropuerto internacional. La instalación está ubicada en 2400 Aviation Drive, en DFW Airport, en los condados de Dallas y Tarrant, Texas 75261. La instalación está solicitando la renovación para descargar aguas pluviales de primer lavado y otras aguas pluviales en los puntos de salida 001, 019, 020, 023 y 059.

Se espera que los vertidos de la instalación contengan aceite y grasa, hidrocarburos totales de petróleo, glicol, aluminio, cobre, zinc y pH. Las aguas pluviales de primer lavado y otras aguas pluviales son tratadas mediante separación por gravedad mediante separadores de combustible ubicados en diversas áreas de rampas industriales, y mediante tratamiento primario en la planta de tratamiento de aguas pluviales de primer lavado del aeropuerto.
