The following summary is provided for this pending water quality permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 39. The information provided in this summary may change during the technical review of the application and are not federal enforceable representations of the permit application.

Freeport LNG Development, L.P. (CN601720345) operates Freeport LNG Pretreatment Facility (RN106481500), a natural gas liquid extraction and natural gas treatment facility. The facility is located 2363 County Road 690, in Freeport, Brazoria County, Texas 77541. The application is a renewal with major amendment to discharge wastewater from the demineralized water treatment system, fire system tests and eyewash/safety shower tests in addition to stormwater from areas with industrial activity via 1 internal outfall (Outfall 101) and 1 external outfall (Outfall 001). The application proposes to remove vehicle washing activities and associated testing parameters from the list of effluent sources, introduce a treatment system for pH control, and remove whole effluent toxicity testing requirements.

Discharges from the facility are expected to contain the following pollutants: oil and grease (O&G), total organic carbon (TOC), total suspended solids (TSS), free oil (sheen), and pH. Wastewater discharges from the demineralized water treatment system, firewater system tests, eyewash/safety shower tests, and stormwater from process areas are treated using pH adjustment prior to discharge through the internal outfall.
