Water will be withdrawn via an intake structure on the LNVA Raw water will be sourced from the Lower Neches Valley Authority (LNVA) to supply the process water and wastewaters will be treated by settling of solids, neutralization, and dechlorination where necessary wastewaters and first flush stormwater will be treated by settling of solids and biological treatment.
