NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION FOR WATER QUALITY TPDES PERMIT FOR MUNICIPAL WASTEWATER

MINOR AMENDMENT

PERMIT NO. WQ0015921001

APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has initiated a minor amendment of the Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0015921001 issued to Liquid Utilities LLC, 6315B Farm-to-Market 1488 Road, Suite 192, Magnolia, Texas 77354, to remove dechlorination requirement from the existing permit. The existing permit authorizes the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 80,000 gallons per day.

The facility will be at 1997 North Farm-to-Market 1486 Road, in Montgomery County, Texas 77356. The treated effluent will be discharged to Little Caney Creek, thence to Lake Creek in Segment No. 1015 of the San Jacinto River Basin. The unclassified receiving water use is high aquatic life use for Little Caney Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 1015 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, and high aquatic life use. For the exact location, refer to the application.

The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit written or oral comment or to ask questions about the application. Generally, the TCEQ will hold a public meeting if the Executive Director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.

After the deadline for public comments, the Executive Director will consider the comments and prepare a response to all relevant and material, or significant public comments. **The response to comments will be mailed to everyone who submitted public comments or who requested to be on a mailing list for this application.**

MAILING LIST. If you submit public comments, you will be added to the mailing list for this specific application to receive future public notices mailed by the Office of the Chief Clerk. In addition, you may request to be placed on: (1) the permanent mailing list for a specific applicant name and permit number; and/or (2) the mailing list for a specific county. If you wish to be placed on the permanent and/or the county mailing list, clearly specify which list(s) and send your request to TCEQ Office of the Chief Clerk at the address below.
