

Magellan Terminals Holdings, L.P. (CN600134639) operates the Magellan Galena Park Terminal (RN102180486), an existing bulk fuels storage and marine terminal for hire. The facility is located at 12901 American Petroleum Road in Galena Park, Harris County, Texas, 77547. The function of this facility is to store liquid hydrocarbons in above ground storage tanks. As required by TCEQ, the facility has applied to renew their existing wastewater discharge permit (WQ0000671000).

The facility proposes to continue discharging stormwater and wastewater at an intermittent and variable-flow rate from Outfalls 001, 002 and 003 depending on the amount of rainfall and wastewater and to decrease the monitoring frequency to 1/quarter. Wastewater is generated at the plant when storage tanks and equipment are washed, and when the boiler (used to heat tanks) discharges blowdown. Stormwater is also discharged from the facility during rainfall events. Pollutants in the facility wastewater may include organic carbon and oil and grease. The facility controls these pollutants by passing wastewater through oil water separators and holdings ponds before it is discharged.
