The facility will be located approximately 2640 feet southeast of the intersection of Raymond Stotzer Pkwy and Texas 47 Frontage Road in Brazos County, Texas 77845., in College Station, Brazos County, Texas 77845.

New application to process wastewater for the community of Casata with a capacity of .12 MGD.

Discharges from the facility are expected to contain Standard Wastewater pollutants, with nitrogen and phosphorus. Domestic Wastewater will be treated by entering the treatment facility at the headworks before flow will split into 2 aeration basins, 2 clarifiers, 2 aerobic digesters, 1 chlorine contact basin, and then outfall. Solids will be pumped out of the aerobic digesters and then trucked to a landfill.
