The following summary is provided for this pending water quality permit application being reviewed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality as required by 30 TAC Chapter 39. City of Kosse (CN600665129) operates the City of Kosse Wastewater Treatment Plant (RN101919702), a domestic wastewater treatment facility. The facility is located at Approximately 1.650 feet northeast of the intersection of West Filmore Street and the Union Pacific Railroad on the west side of Burleson Branch., in Kosse, Limestone County, Texas

76653. Request for renewal of permit authorizing the discharge of 40,000 GPD of treated domestic wastewater.

Discharges from the facility are expected to contain BOD(5), Total Suspended Solids and E. coli. Domestic wastewater is treated by Imhoff followed by stabilization and discharge structure measure and 2 sludge drying beds.

APPLICATION. City of Kosse, P.O. Box 116, Kosse, Texas 76653, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to renew Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0011405001 (EPA I.D. No. TX0105015) to authorize the discharge of treated wastewater at a volume not to exceed a daily average flow of 40,000 gallons per day. The domestic wastewater treatment facility is located approximatly 1650 feet northeast of the intersction of West Filmore Street and the Union Pacific Railroad, near the city of Kosse, in Limestone County, Texas 76653. The discharge route is from the plant site to Burleson Branch; thence to Polecat Creek; thence to Buckhorn Creek; thence to Little Brazos River; thence to Brazos River Above Navasota River. TCEQ received this application on April 29, 2025. The permit application will be available for viewing and copying at Kosse City Hall, 100 North Narcissus, Kosse, in Limestone County, Texas prior to the date this notice is published in the newspaper. After technical review of the application is complete, the Executive Director may prepare a draft permit and will issue a preliminary decision on the application. **Notice of the Application and Preliminary Decision will be published and mailed to those who are on the county-wide mailing list and to those who are on the mailing list for this application. That notice will contain the deadline for submitting public comments.**

PUBLIC COMMENT / PUBLIC MEETING. You may submit public comments or request a public meeting on this application. The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit comments or to ask questions about the application. TCEQ will hold a public meeting if the Executive Director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing. **OPPORTUNITY FOR A CONTESTED CASE HEARING.** After the deadline for submitting public comments, the Executive Director will consider all timely comments and prepare a response to all relevant and material, or significant public comments. **Unless the application is directly referred for a contested case hearing, the response to comments, and the Executive Director's decision on the application, will be mailed to everyone who submitted public comments and to those persons who are on the mailing list for this application. If comments are received, the mailing will also provide instructions for requesting reconsideration of the Executive Director's decision and for requesting a contested case hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.**

Following the close of all applicable comment and request periods, the Executive Director will forward the application and any requests for reconsideration or for a contested case hearing to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting.

The Commission may only grant a request for a contested case hearing on issues the requestor submitted in their timely comments that were not subsequently withdrawn. If a hearing is granted, the subject of a hearing will be limited to disputed issues of fact or mixed questions of fact and law relating to relevant and material water quality concerns submitted during the comment period.

TCEQ may act on an application to renew a permit for discharge of wastewater without providing an opportunity for a contested case hearing if certain criteria are met.






