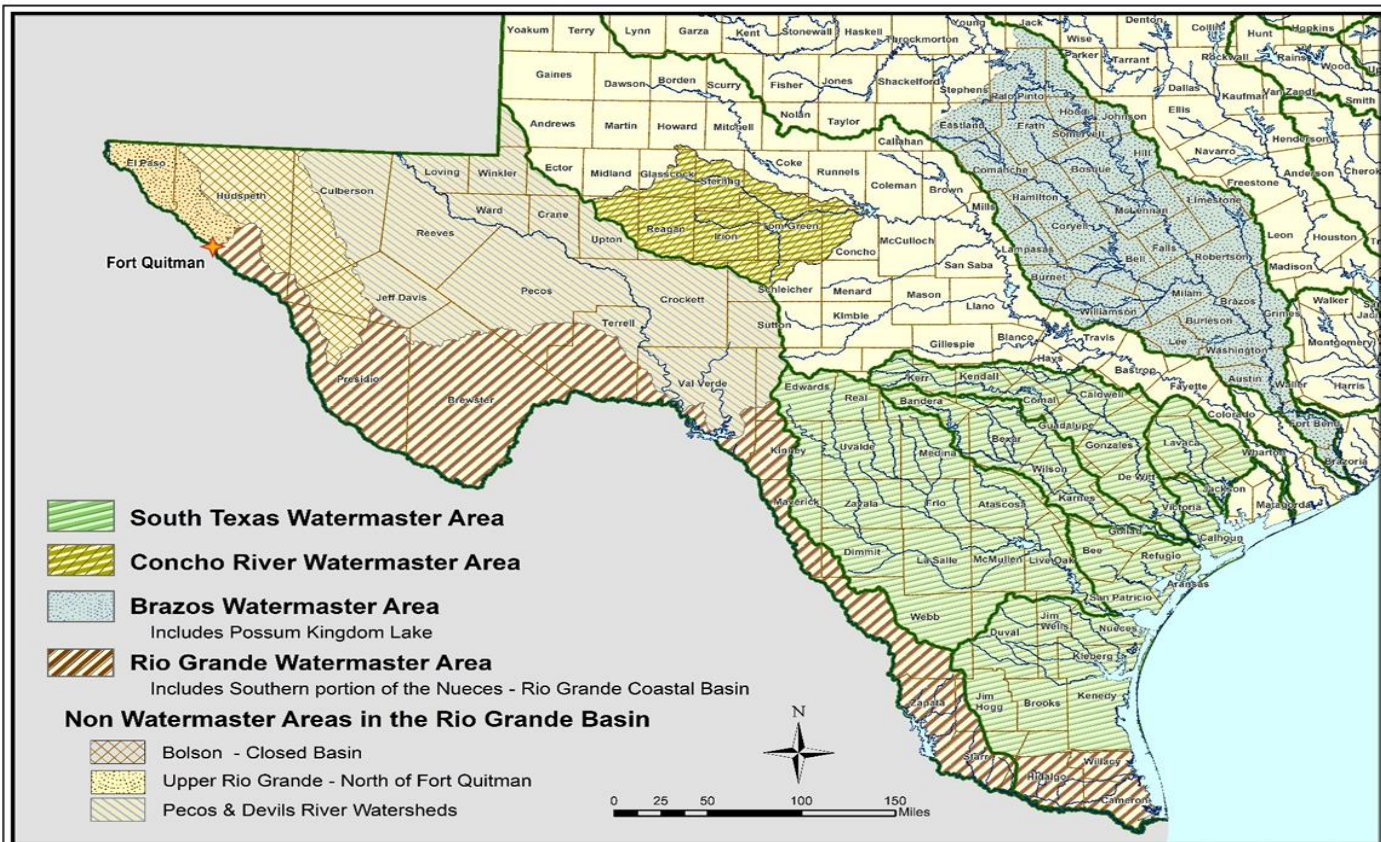

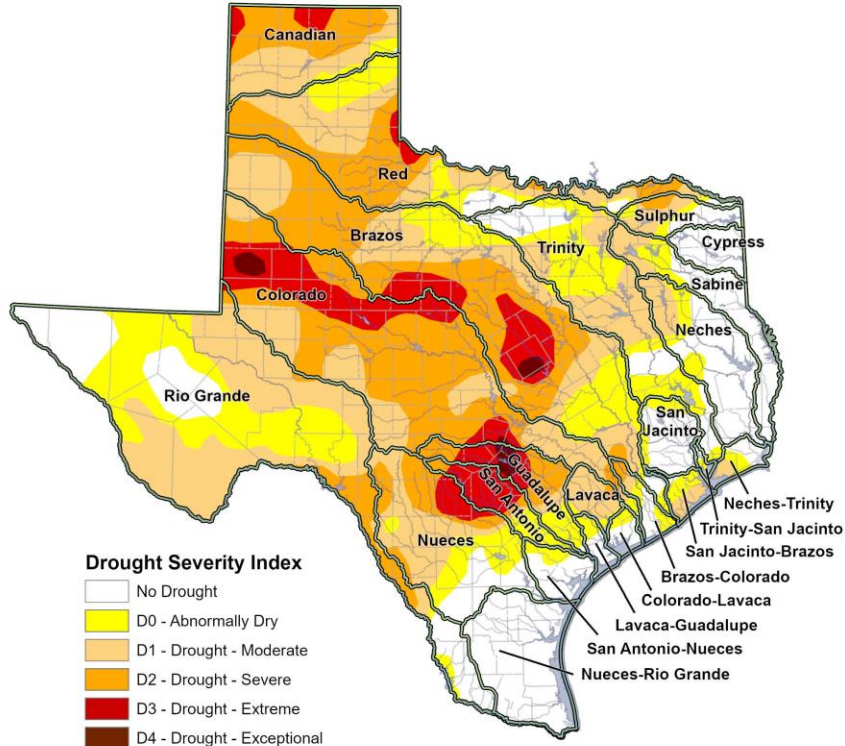

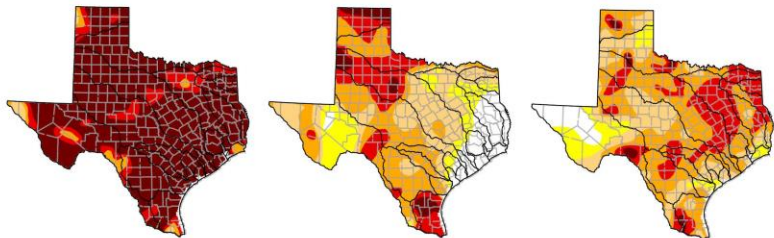


Drought Comparison

September 20, 2022



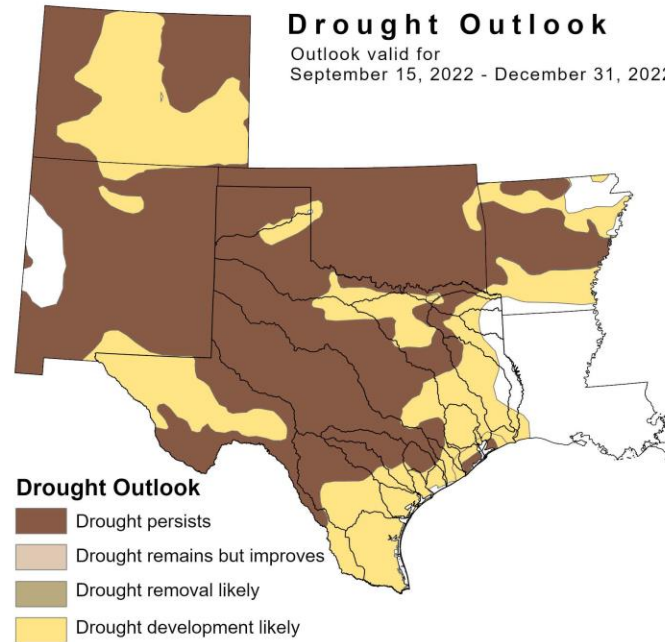
Historical Drought Conditions
