# Administratively Complete Applications

- Target Processing Time: 90 days
- FY22 Q1
  - Received: 20
  - Completed: 16
    - 100% Processed within 90 Days

# House Bill 1964 Applications

- HB1964, passed during the 86<sup>th</sup> legislative session, provided an expedited process for certain water rights applications.
- Target Processing Time: 90 days
- FY22 Q1
  - Received: 1
  - Completed: 1
    - 100% Processed within 90 Days

# Fast Track Applications

- Fast Tracks are applications that don't require substantial modeling.
- Target Processing Time: 300 days
- FY22 Q1
  - Received: 10
  - Completed: 3
    - 100% Processed within 300 Days

# Permitting Updates

- Pending: 136
  - 23 of those have hearing requests
- FY22 Q1
  - Received: 20
  - Completed: 13
    - Issued: 10
    - Withdrawn: 2
    - Returned: 1
- Pre-application meetings will be required starting Jan. 1, 2022

# Change of Ownership and Water Use Reports


- Change of Ownership
  - Average processing time: 47 days
  - 96% processed within 90 days
- Water Use Reports
  - Mailing out January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022
  - Due March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022
    - Electronic submittals: 43%


# Pending Uncontested Water Rights
