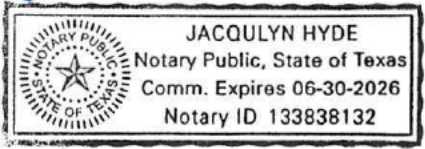

That SOUTHERN MINERALS CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation, with a permit to do business in the State of Texas, and with its principal office and place of business in Corpus Christi, Nueces County, Texas, hereinafter called "Grantor," for and in consideration of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration to it in hand paid by NUECES COUNTY NAVIGATION DISTRICT NO. 1, with its principal office and place of business in Corpus Christi, Texas, hereinafter called "Grantee," has BARGAINED, GRANTED, SOLD and CONVEYED, and by these presents does BARGAIN, GRANT, SELL and CONVEY unto the said NUECES COUNTY NAVIGATION DISTRICT NO. 1, subject to the easements, exceptions and reservations shown of record, the following described land lying and being situated in the County of Nueces, State of Texas, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Being 67.37 acres, more or less, out of Survey 582 patented by the State of Texas to W. S. McGregor by Patent No. 128, Volume 35, and being all that part of the Third Tract North of the S.A.U.&G. Railroad right-of-way described in that certain warranty deed from Houston Oil Company of Texas to Grantor, dated December 18, 1950, and recorded in Volume 499, pages 195-98 of the Deed Records of Nueces County, Texas, said 67.37 acres, more or less, being more particularly described by metes and bounds according to a survey made thereof by Jones & Van Pelt, Inc., in January, 1951, as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North line of the S.A.U.&G. Railroad right-of-way and on the West line of said 67.37 acres for the Southwest corner of said 67.37 acres; Thence North  $0^{\circ} 18' 30''$  West 1121.83 feet to a point for the Northwest corner of the 67.37 acres; Thence South  $87^{\circ} 12' 30''$  East 387.05 feet to a point; Thence North  $81^{\circ} 04' 30''$  East 850 feet to a point; Thence North  $84^{\circ} 47' 30''$  East 200 feet to a point; Thence South  $86^{\circ} 28' 30''$  East 405.15 feet to a point for the Northeast corner of this 67.37 acre tract; Thence South  $0^{\circ} 18' 30''$  East 2142.7 feet to a point in the North line of the S.A.U.&G. Railroad right-of-way for the Southeast corner of said 67.37 acres; Thence in a Northwesterly direction along the North line of the S.A.U.&G. Railroad right-of-way a distance of 2050.75 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, containing 67.37 acres, more or less.

Subject: Access to PCCA Property for Dredging Operations at Avery Point and Bulk Terminal

This correspondence is being provided to you as requested related to the request by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for access to the diversion points identified in the attached exhibit. Access to the Port of Corpus Christi Authority's (PCCA) property at the four (4) locations, as shown in Exhibit A-1, is conditioned upon the following:

1. Temporary access of vehicles, equipment and materials on the PCCA Properties is limited to that reasonably necessary to conduct the work. PCCA Properties may not be used for general storage of vehicles, equipment, and materials unless approved by PCCA prior to storage.
2. The Work will not interrupt or significantly alter existing or future drainage, traffic flow, or site operations on the PCCA Properties.
3. Any permits required for the Work are the responsibility of TTL. TTL will provide copies of all such permits to PCCA Director of Environmental Planning & Compliance within five (5) business days after receipt by TTL.
4. Prior to commencement of any Work, TTL will provide PCCA a current copy of the Health and Safety Plan for the Work and will provide PCCA any subsequent updates to such Plan.
5. In connection with the Work under this Agreement, TTL will comply with all applicable federal, state and local statutes, laws, ordinances, regulations, codes, permits, licenses, authorizations and rules, and other provisions having the force and effect of law, in each case as amended, and including any judicial or administrative orders, determinations, writs, injunctions, judgments and decrees relating to human health or safety, Hazardous Substances or the Environment, including PCCA's Tariff 100-A.
6. TTL shall promptly, at TTL's sole cost and expense, restore and repair (as nearly as practical) any damage to the PCCA Properties caused by the Work to the condition immediately preceding the Work, normal wear and tear excepted, and shall keep Authority free and clear of any mechanic's liens and materialmen's liens in connection with access to the PCCA Properties.



7. TTL agrees to carry and maintain, at its sole expense, the policies of insurance described in Exhibit A attached hereto.
8. Upon execution of a formal agreement between PCCA and TTL, the terms of the formal agreement shall control.

**EXHIBIT A**  
**INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS**

Without limiting the indemnity obligations or liabilities of Grantee or its insurers, provided herein, Grantee agrees to procure and maintain at its sole expense during the term of the Contract the following policies of insurance (sometimes collectively referred to in this exhibit as the "*Policies*") and in at least the minimum amounts specified below:

	In the event that the work of Grantee's employees fall within the purview of the United States Longshore and Harbor Workers' Compensation Act, the Jones Act or the Federal Employers' Liability Act, Grantee shall extend its insurance coverage to provide insurance against the liabilities imposed under the applicable Act or Acts.	
B.	Employer's Liability	\$1,000,000 per Occurrence \$1,000,000 Aggregate
C.	Commercial General Liability	\$3,000,000 per Occurrence \$5,000,000 Aggregate
	The Commercial General Liability shall cover or be endorsed to cover bodily injury, personal injury, broad form property damage, operations hazard, owner's protective coverage, contractual liability, products and completed operations liability, railroad protective liability, marine liability, and time element pollution coverage.	
D.	Business Automobile Liability	\$1,000,000 per Occurrence
	Automobile liability insurance coverage will include all owned, non-owned, and hired vehicles.	
E.	Umbrella Liability	\$5,000,000 per Occurrence
	Umbrella liability coverage will apply to Employer's Liability, Commercial General Liability, and Business Automobile Liability.	
F.	Pollution Liability	\$2,000,000 per Occurrence

Sudden and Accidental Pollution liability insurance covering bodily injury, property damage, environmental cleanup, remediation, disposal, and other losses caused by pollution conditions occurring during the term of this Contract. If Grantee's Commercial General Liability and Umbrella policies contain a deletion of the pollution coverage exclusion, then this policy is not required.

G. Protection & Indemnity (P&I) \$3,000,000 per Occurrence

Should any of the work require marine operations, the Grantee shall provide Protection & Indemnity insurance with respect to bodily injury and/or property damage arising from marine operations.

**Grantee's liability shall not be limited to the specified amounts of insurance required herein. Each policy must contain an endorsement to the effect that the issuer waives any claim or right of subrogation to recover against the Authority, its Port Commissioners, officers and employees ("Authority Parties"). Grantee agrees to immediately provide to each of its insurers written notice of the terms of the waiver set forth in this Exhibit B, and to have said insurance policies properly endorsed, if necessary, to prevent the invalidation of said insurance coverage by reason of said waiver. Grantee will provide to Authority a copy of said endorsement or endorsement or evidence that such endorsement is not necessary to prevent the invalidation of the insurance coverage by reason of such waiver. Additionally, the Authority Parties shall be designated as an Additional Insured either by a blanket additional insured or a specific endorsement on all policies, except for Workers' Compensation and Employer's Liability. Each policy, except Workers' Compensation must contain an endorsement that the policy is primary to any other insurance available to the Additional Insureds with respect to claims arising under this Contract.**

Prior to the execution of this Contract and prior to the expiration date of each of the Policies, Grantee or its insurance producer/broker, shall provide Certificates of Insurance (COI) of the minimum insurance required in this Exhibit. The minimum insurance required may be increased periodically upon request by Authority to commercially reasonable limits. The company writing each of the Policies must possess a current rating with A.M. Best Company of at least "A-, VII".

If Grantee elects to self-insure or to maintain insurance required herein subject to deductibles and/or retentions, Authority and Grantee shall maintain all rights and obligations between themselves as if Grantee maintained the insurance with a commercial insurer including any additional insured status, primary liability, waivers of rights of recovery/subrogation, other insurance clauses, and any other extensions of coverage required herein. Prior to the execution of this Contract, and annually thereafter, Grantee shall provide evidence of self-insured status by issuing a self-insured letter on company letterhead and endorsed by an executive officer of the company. Grantee shall pay from its assets the costs, expenses, damages, claims, losses and

liabilities, including reasonable attorney's fees and necessary litigation expenses at least to the extent that an insurance company would have been obligated to pay those amounts if Grantee had maintained the insurance pursuant to this **Exhibit B**.

Without limiting any of the other obligations or liabilities of Grantee, Grantee shall require each of its contractors performing work on Authority's property pursuant to this Contract, at the contractor's own expense, to maintain during the term of the Contract, the same stipulated minimum insurance as shown herein. As an alternative, Grantee may include its contractors as additional insureds on its own coverage as prescribed under this **Exhibit B**. Grantee's certificate of insurance shall note in such event that its contractors are included as additional insureds and that Grantee agrees to provide workers' compensation for its contractors and the contractor's employees. Grantee shall obtain and monitor the certificates of insurance from each contractor in order to assure compliance with the insurance requirements. Grantee must retain the certificates of insurance for the duration of the Contract plus five (5) years and shall have the responsibility of enforcing these insurance requirements among its contractors. Authority shall be entitled, upon request and without expense, to receive copies of these certificates.

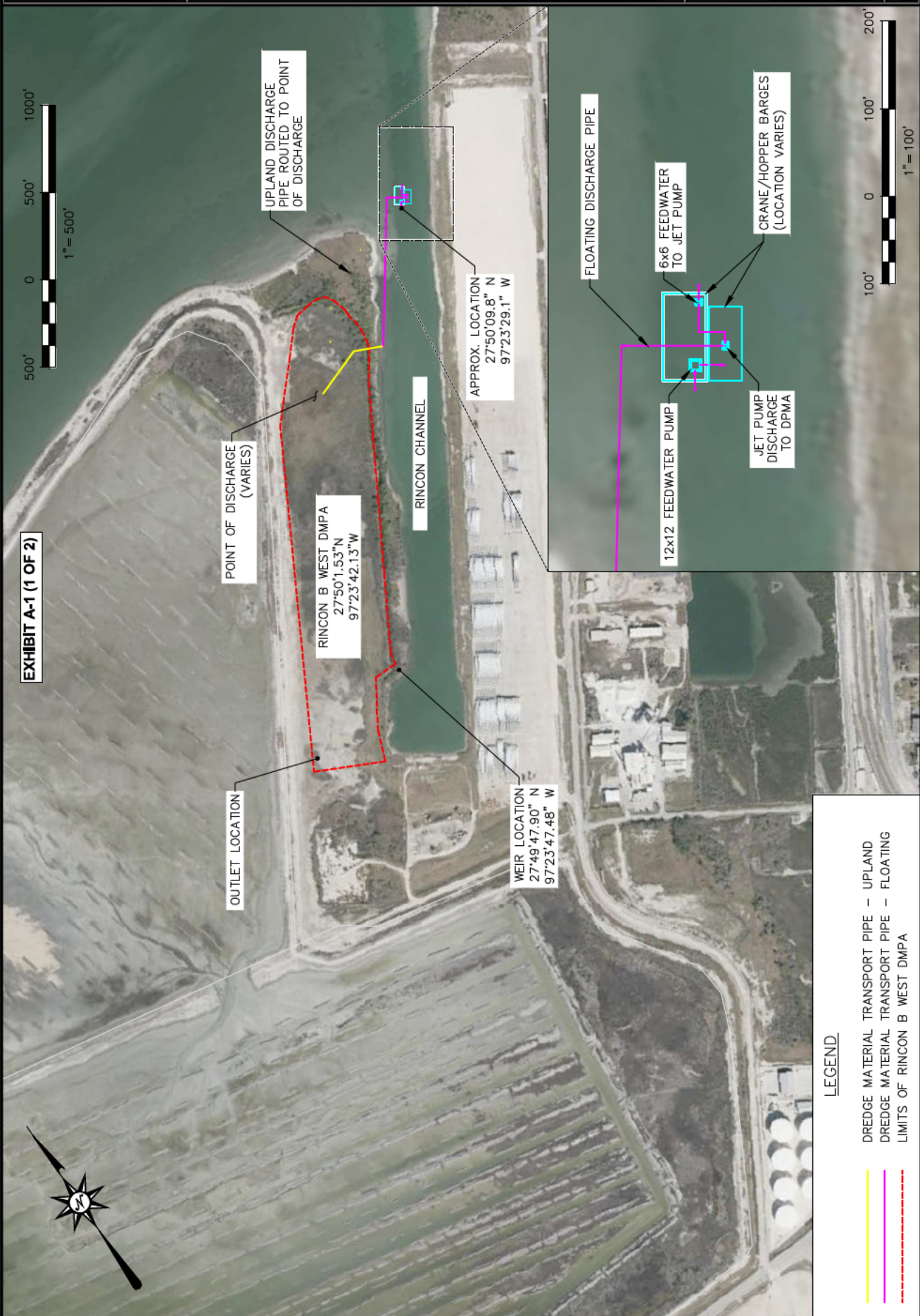

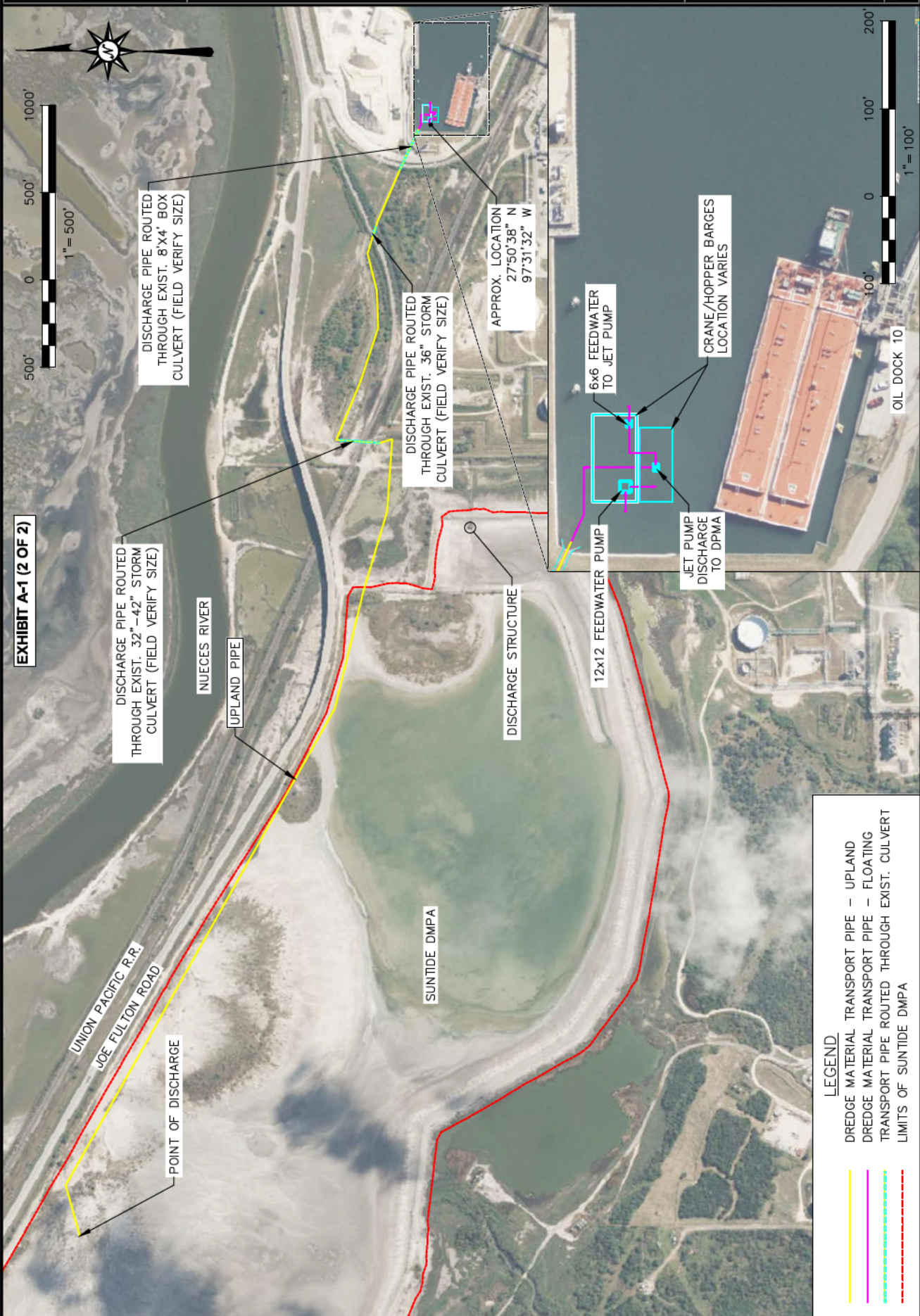
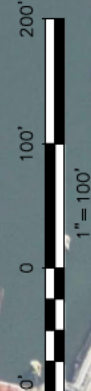
