WHEREAS, by final decree of the 224th District Court of Bexar County, Texas, in Cause No. 78-CI-16903, In Re: The Adjudication of Water Rights in the Medina River of the San Antonio Basin (Exceptions of Edward Walsh, Harry Walsh, Frank Walsh, Bessie Walsh, Anita Walsh and Mary Walsh), dated November 12, 1980, a right was recognized under Claim 2666 authorizing Kittle Nelson Ferguson to appropriate waters of the State of Texas as set forth below;

NCW, THEREFORE, this certificate of adjudication to appropriate waters of the State of Texas in the San Antonio River Basin is issued to Kittie Nelson Ferguson, subject to the following terms and conditions:

IMPOUNDMENT

Owner is authorized to maintain an existing dam and reservoir on San Geronimo Creek and impound therein not to exceed 28.5 acre-feet of water. Point on the dam at the center of the stream is N 45°W, 825 feet from the southeast corner of the R. A. Hill Survey 244.2, Abstract 699 in Bandera County and Abstract 1964 in Medina County, Texas.

2.

Owner is authorized to divert and use not to exceed 5 acre-feet of water per annum from the perimeter of reservoir on San Geronimo Creek to irrigate a maximum of 5 acres of land out of a 149 acre tract located in the R. A. Hill Survey 244.2, Abstract 699 in Bandera County and Abstract 1964 in Medina County, Texas, said 149 acre tract being described as follows:

- (1) BEGINNING at the northwest corner of the R. A. Hill Survey 244.2;
- (2) THENCE south, 950 varas to the southwest corner of said survey;
- THENCE east, 630 varas with south line of said survey to a corner in the west line of a 481 acre tract;
- THENCE north, 187 varas with west line of said 481 acre tract to a stone mound;
- (5) THENCE east, 320 varas to a stone mound in the east line of said Survey 244.2;
- THENCE north, 763 varas to the northeast corner of said Survey 244.2;
- (7) THENCE west, 950 varas to the place of beginning.

DIVERSION 3.

At the perimeter of the aforesaid reservoir on San Geronimo Creek.

Maximum Rate: 0.2 cfs (80 gpm).

3. PRIORITY

The time priority of owner's right is 1963.

This certificate of adjudication is issued subject to all terms, conditions and provisions provided for in the final decree of the 224th District Court of Bexar County, Texas, in Cause No. 78-CI-16903, In Re: The Adjudication of Water Rights in the Medina River of the San Antonio Basin (Exceptions of Edward Walsh, Harry Walsh, Frank Walsh, Bessie Walsh, Anita Walsh and Mary Walsh), dated November 12, 1980, and supersedes all rights of the owner asserted in that cause.

This certificate of adjudication is issued subject to senior and superior water rights in the San Antonio River Basin.

This certificate of adjudication is issued subject to the Rules of the Texas Department of Water Resources and its continuing right of supervision of State water resources consistent with the public policy of the State as set forth in the Texas Water Code.

This water right is appurtenant to the above-described land within which irrigation is authorized, unless and until severed from the land. A transfer of any portion of the above-described land includes, unless otherwise specified, that portion of the water right which is appurtenant to the transferred land at the time of the transaction.

Dear Mr. & Mrs. Kent:

This acknowledges the receipt of the *Change of Ownership Form*, the two *Special Warranty Deeds with Vendor's Lien*, the three *General Warranty Deeds*, and \$100 in application fees (Receipt R423324C), we are changing our records to reflect Jeff and Dana Kent as part owner of Certificate of Adjudication No. 19-2135.

Certificate of Adjudication No. 19-2135 authorizes Jeff and Dana Kent to divert and use 0.41 acre-feet of water per year from the reservoir on San Gerinimo Creek, San Antonio Basin, for agricultural purposes to irrigate 0.41 acres out of a 12.23- acre tract in the R.A. Hill Survey 244.2, Abstract 699 and 1964, Bandera and Medina County.

Please keep in mind that the 0.41 acre-feet of water for agricultural water rights referenced above are appurtenant to the entire 12.23 acres of land referenced above. As such, a conveyance of any portion of these acres, in the future, will automatically carry a proportionate share of the water right to the new owner unless it specifies otherwise in the conveyance.
