5. Reason(s) for delay and why the proposed dates requested are necessary

Under 30 TAC 295.72(b) the applicant must include* why the extension should be granted and why the permit should not be forfeited if the commission finds that sufficient due diligence to begin and/or complete construction of the authorized project has not been demonstrated. Reasonable causes for delay include, but are not limited to, the operation of legal proceedings or other causes which were not within the reasonable control of the permittee and which were reasonably unforeseeable at the time of the appropriation or the last extension. Financial hardship shall not, by itself, constitute sufficient cause for the granting of an extension. Notice of the application, if required, will also indicate that the Commission will consider whether the appropriation shall be forfeited by the applicant, if the extension is denied.

As indicated to TCEQ staff at the time of permit issuance, JMLLC did not expect to complete these projects by November 2018 due to the massive volumes of dirt required to construct each of these ponds.

Reclamation of the subject areas continues. The five ponds approved in this permit are at various stages of construction. None of the ponds require construction of embankments. Remaining construction consists of completion of slopes and pond volumetrics, inlets, spillways, and bypass structures. Under the applicable mining permits issued by the Railroad Commission of Texas (RCT), the design of the bypass structures will be required to be submitted, reviewed and approved as permanent structures. This may add as much as 6 months time to the completion of each structure.

Since our last extension request, the RCT has placed additional time constraints on completing final reclamation in different areas of the mine by a particular date. We have had to schedule our equipment to meet these deadlines which has taken time away from completing the footprints of the mine where our permanent water rights ponds are located.


