Jewett Mine LLC seeks authorization to extend the time to complete construction of five reservoirs, located on Buffalo Creek, Bow Branch, Rena Branch, Taylor Springs Branch, and Silver Creek, Trinity River Basin for recreational, domestic and livestock purposes in Freestone and Leon Counties. More information on the application and how to participate in the permitting process is given below.

APPLICATION. Jewett Mine LLC, P.O. Box 915, Jewett, Texas 75846, Applicant/Permittee, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for an extension of time pursuant to Texas Water Code § 11.145, and TCEQ Rules Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 295.1, et seq. Notice is being published and mailed to the water rights holders of record in the Trinity River Basin pursuant to Title 30 TAC § 295.159(a).

Water Use Permit No. 12292 authorizes Jewett Mine, LLC to construct and maintain five reservoirs with a combined normal capacity of 5,469 acre-feet of water on Buffalo Creek, tributary of Upper Keechi Creek, tributary of Trinity River; Bow Branch, tributary of Alligator Creek, tributary of Buffalo Creek; Rena Branch, tributary of Alligator Creek; Taylor Springs Branch, tributary of Silver Creek, tributary of Alligator Creek; and Silver Creek, Trinity River Basin in Freestone and Leon counties for recreational, domestic, and livestock purposes in Zip Code 78456. The time priority of this water right is December 3, 2009.

Multiple special conditions and time limitations apply, including the requirement to complete construction of the five reservoirs within three years of the issuance of this permit on November 13, 2015.

Permittee has previously been granted two orders extending the time to complete construction of the five reservoirs. The current order, issued on March 24, 2021, required Permittee to complete construction by December 31, 2022.

Applicant seeks authorization for an additional extension of time to complete construction of the five reservoirs by December 31, 2024.

The application was received on January 26, 2023 and partial fees were received on February 6, 2023. Additional fees were received on April 18, 2023. The application was declared administratively complete and accepted for filing with the Office of the Chief Clerk on April 26, 2023.

The Executive Director has determined that the applicant has shown due diligence and justification for delay. In the event a hearing is held on this application, the Commission shall also consider whether the authorization for the appropriation shall be forfeited for failure to demonstrate sufficient due diligence and justification for delay.

The Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft Order. The draft Order, if granted, would authorize the extension of time to complete construction of the five reservoirs. The application, technical memoranda and Executive

Under 30 TAC 295.72(b) the applicant must include* why the extension should be granted and why the permit should not be forfeited if the commission finds that sufficient due diligence to begin and/or complete construction of the authorized project has not been demonstrated. Reasonable causes for delay include, but are not limited to, the operation of legal proceedings or other causes which were not within the reasonable control of the permittee and which were reasonably unforeseeable at the time of the appropriation or the last extension. Financial hardship shall not, by itself, constitute sufficient cause for the granting of an extension. Notice of the application, if required, will also indicate that the Commission will consider whether the appropriation shall be forfeited by the applicant, if the extension is denied.

As indicated to TCEQ staff at the time of permit issuance, JMLLC did not expect to complete these projects by November 2018 due to the massive volumes of dirt required to construct each of these ponds.

Reclamation of the subject areas continues. The five ponds approved in this permit are at various stages of construction. None of the ponds require construction of embankments. Remaining construction consists of completion of slopes and pond volumetrics, inlets, spillways, and bypass structures. Under the applicable mining permits issued by the Railroad Commission of Texas (RCT), the design of the bypass structures will be required to be submitted, reviewed and approved as permanent structures. This may add as much as 6 months time to the completion of each structure.

Since our last extension request, the RCT has placed additional time constraints on completing final reclamation in different areas of the mine by a particular date. We have had to schedule our equipment to meet these deadlines which has taken time away from completing the footprints of the mine where our permanent water rights ponds are located.


