**IV. Watermaster Program Updates and Reports: Amy Settemeyer**

**A) Quarterly Financial Reports:**

Amy Settemeyer presented the Financial Report. The Fund Balance at the beginning of FY18 was \$550,036.54, at the end of FY18 the balance was \$579,328.28. Amy stated that most of the extra money came from the employee vacancy during the year.

**B) Watermaster Report: Jose (Lupe) Luna**

Lupe Luna reported on December 1, 2018, the US storage in both reservoirs was 61.83%, amounting to 2,970,307 acre-feet. Amistad storing, 1,319,025 acre-feet and Falcon storing, 778,282 acre-feet. Mexico storage in both reservoirs was 36.65%, amounting to 927,452 acre-feet. Amistad storing, 563,443 acre-feet and Falcon storing, 364,009 acre-feet. The current TDS is 810ppm at Anzalduas.

**V. Report on Mexico water deliveries: Amy Settemeyer**

Amy Settemeyer reported as of Dec 1, 2018, Mexico has delivered 1,074,479 acre-feet this 5-year cycle; we are in the fourth year of this cycle. Mexico is currently 11,959 acre-feet behind on deliveries.

**VI. El Morillo Drain update: Lupe Luna**

Lupe Luna reported the drain is currently not spilling and hasn't spilled in over a month.
