Section 11.329(b) of the Water Code requires the executive director to provide notice to water right holders at least 30 days prior to the Commission holding a public hearing on the proposed fiscal year budget. That public notice will be mailed following the completing of the WAC meeting and at least 30 days before the date of the proposed budget being considered during a Commission agenda meeting.
