

NOTICE

LANDSCAPE IRRIGATORS MUST BE LICENSED!

In Texas it's against the law to conduct or advertise landscape irrigation services without a Texas landscape irrigator's license.

This applies to business cards, flyers, published ads, signs, lettering on trucks or trailers, Yellow Pages ads, electronic ads (including Craigslist), etc. These materials must display a valid landscape irrigator's license number.

Violators of this law could face administrative fines or other enforcement action.

What is a landscape irrigator's license?

There are three types of licenses:

1. An irrigator can sell, design, maintain, alter, or repair irrigation systems.
2. A technician can work for a licensed irrigator, and can maintain, alter, or repair irrigation systems.
3. An irrigation inspector can inspect irrigation systems for a municipality or water district.

What are the requirements?

An irrigator must:

1. Pass an approved basic irrigation course.
2. Submit an application.
3. Pay a licensing fee.

A technician must:

1. Pass an approved technician course.
2. Submit an application.
3. Pay a licensing fee.

An irrigation inspector must:

1. Pass an approved basic irrigation course.
2. Pass an approved backflow prevention testing course.
3. Pass an approved water-conservation or audit course.
4. Submit an application.
5. Pay a licensing fee.
