**Invitations for Remedial Action Program**

The Texas Water Commission (TWC) invites independent third parties to participate voluntarily in a remedial action program for the following state superfund sites: Munoz Borrow Pits, Mission; McBay Oil and Gas, Grapeland; and Hall Street, Dickinson.

This invitation is issued pursuant to the Texas Solid Waste Disposal Act, Texas Civil Statutes, Article 4477-7, §13(g)(1)(C). Independent third parties who willingly participate in the voluntary clean up of the facilities listed above: shall be required to contract with the Texas Water Commission; and may only seek cost recovery pursuant to §11(b) from those liable parties not participating in the voluntary cleanup. This does not imply that any remedial action program undertaken by an independent third party will be reimbursed by the state. Therefore, this invitation should not be construed as an invitation for bids or as a request for proposals.
