

SAN JACINTO RIVER WASTE PITS SUPERFUND SITE COMMUNITY MEETING Highlands, Texas Harris County Thursday, November 15, 2012 6:30 p.m.



The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), in cooperation with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), Harris County, Federal and State agencies, and local officials, will conduct a Superfund Community Meeting for the San Jacinto Waste Pits site from **6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Thursday, November 15, 2012,** at the Highlands Community Center, 604 Highland Woods Drive, Highlands, TX.

This informal meeting is to provide the community with an update on the EPA's cleanup of the site located on the west bank of the San Jacinto River directly north of the I-10 Bridge.

This meeting will give residents the opportunity to ask questions to agency and other officials and to provide input on this important Superfund cleanup project. Action items to be discussed include the ongoing Remedial Investigation, the southern impoundment; status of the site stabilization Cap, and future activities and cleanup schedule.
